


GILLAM WAY RECONSTRUCTION

2019 CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION



The Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, in partnership with Exclusive Paving, will be reconstructing Gillam Way from Airport Way to 22nd Avenue, including constructing and upgrading sidewalks and shoulders, upgrading intersections, and installing traffic calming features.

Construction details:

- Construction is expected to start on June 27, 2019 and be complete by October.
- Crews will be working from 7 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Monday to Saturday.
- Mailboxes will be temporarily moved to a central location. We will notify residents when the mailboxes are moved.
- There will be periodic, brief interruptions to water and sewer services for area residents. More information about the utility work schedule will be available as the project progresses.

Traffic details:

- This project will be constructed in two phases. First, Gillam Way from Airport Way to 17th Avenue will be closed starting June 27.
- During the second phase, Gillam Way will be closed from 17th to 22nd Avenue for the remainder of construction.
- These closures are necessary due to the deep trenching needed for utility work. There is not enough space around the trenches for vehicles to safely navigate through the construction zone.
- 17th Avenue will remain open to through-traffic, although no turns onto Gillam will be permitted.
- MACS Transit routes will be detoured around this project, so please be aware you may need to use a different bus stop. Contact MACS Transit for specific information about your bus route.
- Pedestrian and bicycle access will be maintained throughout this project.
